ORDINANCE

*An Ordinance of the Lilly Borough
Council being the 2017 Tax Ordinance*

WHEREAS, Section 1302 of the Borough Code authorizes borough council to levy and collect annually a tax, not exceeding thirty mills for general borough purposes; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectively manage and conduct the borough's affairs, the Council deems it necessary and appropriate to levy the taxes hereindescribed.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lilly Borough Council hereby and herein **ORDAINS AND ENACTS** as follows:

ARTICLE I

Per Capita Tax

The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a per capita tax in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00).

ARTICLE II

Local Services Tax

The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a local services tax in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00).

ARTICLE III
Real Estate Tax

The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a tax rate for general purposes at the rate of twelve and one-half (12 1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation for the year 2017. The said tax shall be paid when due and if delinquent, shall carry a ten percent (10%) penalty.

ARTICLE IV
Realty Transfer Tax

The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a realty transfer tax in the amount of one-half of one percent of the fair market value of the property transferred.
