

ORDINANCE NO. 1985-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF LILLY PROVIDING FOR THE IRREVOCABLE COMMITMENT OF CERTAIN STATE FUNDS PAYABLE TO THE BOROUGH OF LILLY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Lilly, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. Any state funds previously paid to and not expended or any funds payable to the Borough of Lilly, the payment of which has been withheld or prevented by action of the Auditor General of Pennsylvania pursuant to Section 1.2 of the Act of May 12, 1943, (P.L. 259, No. 120), referred to as the Foreign Casualty Insurance Premium Tax Allocation Law, taken since January 1, 1982, will be transferred to the Police Pension Fund and are irrevocably committed to be expended only in accordance with the Foreign Casualty Insurance Premium Tax Allocation Law.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
