Ordinance No. 1989-5

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MAINTENANCE OF DOGS, CATS OR OTHER ANIMALS WHICH CREATE OFFENSIVE ODORS, EXCESSIVE NOISE OR UNSANITARY OR UNSAFE CONDITIONS; DEFINING THE CONDITIONS WHICH CREATE A NUISANCE FOR THE SAME; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Borough of Lilly hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I No person shall, in the Borough of Lilly, maintain a dog, cat or other animal which creates offensive odors, excessive noise or unsanitary conditions so as to constitute a menace to the health, comfort or safety of the public, and no person shall, in the Borough of Lilly, otherwise commit or permit the existence of a nuisance as defined hereinafter.

SECTION II Any dog, cat or other animal which, by frequent and habitual barking, howling, screaming, yelping or baying, or in which in any way or manner disturbs the rightful tranquility of any person in the Borough of Lilly, or which otherwise disturbs or endangers the health, comfort or safety of any person in the Borough of Lilly, is, for purposes of this Ordinance, a nuisance. It shall be unlawful for any person in the Borough of Lilly to maintain any animal which is such a nuisance.

SECTION III Any cat dog or other animal which scratches, digs or defecates upon any lawn, tree, shrub, plant, building or any other public or private property within the Borough of Lilly,

other than the property of the owner of such animal, is, for purposes of this Ordinance, a nuisance. It shall be unlawful for any person in the Borough of Lilly to maintain any animal which is such a nuisance.

SECTION IV Persons with defective eyesight or hearing shall be exempt from the operation of this Ordinance while relying upon a dog utilized to assist in overcoming these defects.

SECTION V Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00), and, in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Cambria County Prison for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

SECTION VI This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after date.
