ORDINANCE NO. 1998-2

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING UNLAWFUL SKATEBOARDING, ROLLER SKATING, SCOOTER RIDING OR OTHER SIMILAR RIDING AND ALSO PROHIBITING THE ERECTION OR PLACEMENT OF ANY RAMP OR OTHER INCLINE OR DECLINE DESIGNED FOR SKATEBOARDING, ROLLER SKATING, SCOOTER RIDING, PEDACYCLE RIDING OR OTHER SIMILAR TYPE RIDING, ALL WITHIN THE BOROUGH AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY THERE FOR.

NOW, THEREFORE, in the interest of public safety, be it Ordained and Enacted by the Council of the Borough of Lilly, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful for any person to ride upon, or utilize in any manner, upon the roadways, streets, sidewalks or other vehicular or pedestrian traffic ways in the Borough of Lilly, or upon any property owned, leased, managed or under the control of the Borough of Lilly, any skateboard, roller skates, roller blades, scooter or other human powered device, other than a pedacycle, that being a vehicle propelled solely by human powered pedals.

SECTION 2

It shall be unlawful for any person to erect or place any type of ramp or other incline or decline designed for the use of skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, scooters, pedacycles, or any other human powered vehicles on to the roadways, streets, sidewalks or other vehicular or pedestrian traffic ways in the Borough of Lilly, or on any property owned, leased, managed or under the control of the Borough of Lilly.

SECTION 3

The penalty for violation of this Ordinance shall be a fine not to exceed Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars for each violation, or imprisonment to the extent allowed by law for the punishment of summary offenses.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance may be enforced by an action brought before a District Justice in the same manner provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure.

SECTION 5

The Lilly Borough Police, or any other law enforcement officer otherwise authorized, shall enforce the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Council of the Borough of Lilly, that this Ordinance would have been adopted has such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION 7

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8

This Ordinance shall become effective the 1st day of January, 1999.
