**ORDINANCE NO. 2005-1**

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING OR REESTABLISHING A MAXIMUM VEHICULAR SPEED LIMIT OF TWENTY-FIVE (25) MILES PER HOUR ON VARIOUS STREETS, OR PORTIONS THEREOF, ALL WITHIN THE JURISDICTIONAL LIMITS OF THE BOROUGH OF LILLY AND ALL IN CONFORMITY WITH THE VEHICLE CODE OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

The Council of the Borough of Lilly, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania enacts and ordains, under the authority of, and pursuant to, Section 3362(a)(1.2) of the Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 75 Pa. C.S.A. 3362(a)(1.2), the following:

1. The Borough of Lilly hereby establishes, or reestablishes, a maximum vehicular speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on the following streets, or portions thereof, within the jurisdictional limits of the Borough of Lilly:

Railroad Street – old recycle plant to North Street  
Mountain Road – Portage Street to Borough line  
Main Street – Railroad Street to High Street  
Piper Street – Portage Street to Hemlock Street  
Harris Street – Piper Street to Williams Street  
Hemlock Street – Piper Street to Williams Street  
Jones Street – Portage Street to Borough line  
Curran Street – Jones Street to dead end  
Poplar Lane – Jones Street to dead end  
Washington Street – Railroad Street to Portage Street  
Willow Street – Cleveland Street to Borough line  
North Street – Railroad Street to Cambria Street  
Williams Street – Hemlock Street to Portage Street  
Church Street – Evergreen Street to Cemetery Street  
Cemetery Street – George Street to Corrigan Street  
George Street – Wood Street to Ryan Street  
Barker Street – Corrigan Street to Church Street

White Street – Corrigan Street to Church Street  
Pine Street – George Street to dead end  
Cleveland Street – Railroad Street to Portage Street  
Hagen Street – Main Street to Evergreen Street  
High Street – Main Street to Route 53  
Adele Street – dead end to dead end  
Cambria Street – Curran Street to North Street  
Hawthorne Street – Cemetery Street to Church Street  
Grant Street – Railroad Street to Portage Street

2. Said maximum vehicular speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour shall be posted on fixed or variable official traffic-control devices erected in accordance with regulations from time to time adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Motor Vehicles.

3. Penalties for violating said maximum vehicular speed limit of twenty-five (25) minutes per hour shall be in accordance with subsection (c), as it currently exists or is subsequently modified, of Section 3362 of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa. C.S.A. 3362(c), or its successor provision or provisions.

4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances and all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions that are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be, and the same expressly are, hereby repealed.

5. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance, it being the intent of the Borough that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

6. This Ordinance shall be interpreted under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

7. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
