TREES

1996-1 Protection of trees and replacement

UTILITIES

1914-13 Tax of \$0.50 cents per pole upon all telegraph, telephone, electric light or other pole used to carry wires for the transmission of electric currant

1914-15 All utilities poles in the Borough will pay an annual fee of \$0.25 per pole annually

1920-22 Poles for lighting, heating, and power will not interfere with passage of water drainage

1920-23 Grant Light, Heat, and Power Companies and successors right to lay, construct, operate, and maintain system of pipes in the streets

1921-28 Heat, and Power Company of Lilly and its successors have right to lay, construct, operate and maintain a system of pipes in the street

WATER

1927-48 Lilly Borough desire to purchase water company

1973-3 Provide for the installation of water lines and taps

1977-2 Operation of waterworks of Lilly and rates and regulations penalty for violations

1980-3 Amending of Lilly Borough Ordinance 1973 section nine rates for water taps

- 1980-4 Amend number 1977 for tap fees
- 2010-5 Owners to improve property adjacent to water lines are to connect to water system
- 2012-1 Testing of property to determine if illegal storm or surface water is connected to sewers and penalties if so needed
- 2011-5 Owners to improve property adjacent to water lines
