

ORDINANCE 4

For The Protection Of The Fire Company: It's Hose, Water Plugs & Carriages

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:--That any person or persons in any manner whatever interfering with hose, fire plugs or carriage while out at calls of fire shall be deemed guilty of disorderly conduct, and shall upon conviction, be fined not less than three nor more than ten dollars, at the discretion of the Chief Burgess.

Section 2. That any person or persons while the hose is ~~across~~ ^{any} any street or alley in practice or testing said hose, or at the time of fire who shall wilfully and wantonly drive or drag any sled, wagon, cart, or other vehicle over said hose, shall upon conviction be fined not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars for said offense at the discretion of the Chief Burgess; providing that while in practice or testing no team or conveyance as above mentioned shall be detained upon a public street or alley by the hose for a longer time than five minutes.

Passed finally by the Town Council of the Borough of Lilly this first day of June A.D. 1906.
