ORDINANCE 5

Providing For The Extending, Laying Out And Opening Of North Street IN The Borough Of Lilly From Main Street Westerly To North Railroad Street.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough Of Lilly, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same. That North Street in the said Borough shall be extended out and opened as a public street and highway of the said Borough from it's present terminus at Main Street westerly so as to connect with North Railroad Street, according to the following courses and distances to Wit:— For the center of said extension North Street beginning at a post on the westerly side of Main Street opposite the intersection of North Street and midway between the properties of George Risban on the northerly side and Mrs. L. Callahan on the southerly side: thence north seventy-six (76) degrees, thirty-six minutes (36), west a distance of one hundred (100) feet to a post: thence north eighty-three (83) degrees, thirty-six minutes (36), west a distance of three-hundred-thirty (330) feet to a line of North Railroad Street.

Section 2. That the width of said street shall be forty (40) feet, twenty feet (20) of which shall be on each side of the aforesaid center line, according to the lines shown on the map or plot of said extension of North Street made by S.G. Fetterman Borough Engineer and dated September 24th, 1906.

Section 3. That all the land lying between the said forty (40) feet as mention and described in this ordinance to Wit: -- thesection one hudred feet in lenght and forty (40) feet in width lying between the properties of George Risban and Mrs. L. Callahan and heretofore intended as land for a street, and the portions of lots of land lying within the lines above mentioned, in the name of M.K. Riper, J.H. Connel and T.A. Bradley one the one side and the land of F.C. George and Mrs. John Short on the other side and the same are hereby taken, appropriated and set apart for public of a street, or highway of the said Borough of Lilly.

Section 4. That the Chief Burgess and the Borough Sectetary be and they are hereby instructed in the name and by the authority of the Borough of Lilly to proceed to have said street opened as herein laid out and if they cannot agree with the owners of land through which the same is extended upon the damages, proceed according to law to have the said street, to give such security as the proper Court may require to be said property owners for the damages sustained, by the opening of said street, and to bind the Borough by the execution of a bond or bonds for the purpose.

Section 5. That all ordinances and regulations of the Borough of Lilly heretofore enacted and applicable to the street and highways thereof be and the same are hereby extended and applied to the said North Street, as herein extended.
