ORDINANCE 11

Regulating The Speed Of Automobiles And Motorcycles Through The Streets, Lanes And Alleys Of Lilly Borough

Section:

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, in the County of Combria, State of Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted by authority of the same that it shall be unlawful for Automobiles or Motorcycles to pass through the streets, lanes, and alleys of Borough of Lilly at a greater speed than eight (8) miles per hour; any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction be subject to a fine of not less than one nor more than twenty-five dollars or on failure of fine and costs an imprisonment in the Borough Lock-up seventy-two hours. Providing nothing herein contained shall apply to any officer in discharge of his duty or when human life is in danger.
