

ORDINANCE 12

Adopting A Plan Of The Lilly Borough And Defining The Location And Limits Of The Streets, Avenues And Alleys Of Said Borough, And Declaring Them Public Highways.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

Section 1. That the map or plan of the Borough of Lilly as prepared by D.W.Dillman, Borough Engineer and now in the office of the Clerk of Council of said Borough, be and the same is hereby adopted as the official map or plan of the said Borough, and that all subdivisions of property here after made shall conform thereto.

Section 2. That the streets, lanes and alleys as located by courses and distances on said map be and the same are hereby declared public highways of the Borough of Lilly.

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council be, and he is hereby authorized, appointed, and constituted to acknowledge the said map or plan before any authority under the laws of this Commonwealth to take such acknowledgement as and for the act and deed of the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly with the intent that the same may be duly recorded.
