

ORDINANCE 17

Of The Borough Of Lilly, County Of Cambria And State Of Pennsylvania
Admitting Certain Lots or Outlots To Said Borough.

Whereas a petition of a majority of the freehold owners or certain lots or outlots of a certain section of land situated in the Township of Washington, County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, adjoining the Borough of Lilly has been presented to the Burgess and Town Council of said Borough praying that said lots or outlots be admitted to said Borough; and whereas, the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, deem it expedient to grant the prayer of the petitioners. Therefore be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the lots or outlots of that certain section of land in the Township of Washington, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania lying adjacent to said Borough and herein after described, be and the same are hereby admitted to said Borough, and the limits of the Borough of Lilly are hereby extended so as to include the same, the description of said lots or outlots being as follows:

Number 1. Beginning at a stone monument set in the boundary line, north eighty-one degrees fifty-five minutes, west one thousand three hundred and seventy-six ~~minutes~~ feet to a point; thence still by said boundary line, south forty-five degrees fifty minutes, west three hundred sixty-nine feet to a stake in the west line of Cemetery Street north twenty-four degrees forty-five minutes, west three hundred fifty-five feet to its intersection with the north line of Corregan Street produced; thence along said line of Corregan Street north eighty-nine degrees east seven hundred and three feet to a point, a corner of the property of Cora M. Hite; thence along line of Cora M. Hite due north sixty feet to ^{an} other corner of the said Cora M. Hite; thence along line of the aforesaid Cora M. Hite and crossing Barker Street north eighty seven degrees thirty minutes east one hundred eighty-four feet to the east line of Barker Street; thence along said line east of Barker Street north nineteen degrees twenty-seven minutes, west one hundred seventy-four and five tenths feet to a point; thence still by the east line of Barker Street north one degree thirty-five minutes east nine hundred and two and five tenths feet to a point; thence south eighty-seven degrees forty minutes east eight hundred and forty seven feet to a point in the right-of-way line of the Pennsylvania Railroad Company; thence along said right-of-way line by a curve to the left with a radius of two thousand nine hundred twenty-seven and nine tenths feet a distance of one hundred and seventy three feet to a point; thence still by said right of way line south eight degrees four minutes west five hundred and four feet to a point; thence south eighty-four degrees forty minutes east six hundred and seventy-nine feet to a post in the west line of Township Road (Known as Main Street) thence south eighty-two degrees fifty-six minutes east four hundred and ten feet to a stake; thence south thirty-nine degrees thirty-one minutes east six hundred and twenty-three feet to a stone monument in the boundary line of the Borough of Lilly and the place of beginning.

Number 2. Beginning at a concrete monument set in the boundary line of the Borough of Lilly; thence south sixty degrees east two hundred and eighty feet and three tenths of a foot to a point; thence south seven degrees eight minutes west two hundred and seventy one and four tenths feet to a point thence north eighty one degrees thirty minutes west four hundred and thirty feet to a point in the said boundary line north forty-one degrees forty-five minutes east four hundred and fifteen feet to a concrete monument and the place of beginning.

Section 2. It is further provided that a plan or plot showing the boundary of the Borough of Lilly and of the section admitted thereto by this ordinance, together with a certified copy of this ordinance, and a description of the boundaries of the Borough or Town, and of the Borough or Town as extended, giving the courses and distances as required by the Act of the General Assembly approved the twenty first day of March A.D. 1907, pamphlet Laws 25, shall be filed in the court of quarter sessions Of Cambria County.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
