

ORDINANCE 20

Requiring owners, proprietors, and operators of poolrooms, bowling alleys, shooting galleries and motion picture houses operating within the Borough of Lilly, to procure a license before engaging in or continuing such business; providing for collection, use, amount of license and fixing a closing hour of such amusements.

Be it enacted by the Town Council and the Burgess of Lilly Borough, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that on and after the passage of its ordinance it shall be unlawful for any owner, proprietor, or operator of Poolrooms, Bowling Alleys, Shooting Galleries or Motion Picture House or Theatre, and whether such owner be a resident, citizen, or otherwise; to engage in or continue such business within the Borough of Lilly without procuring a license from the Chief Burgess of said Borough.

The license shall be paid for the use of the Borough, and its amount fixed by the Burgess within the following limits: For Poolrooms and Bowling Alley not less than five dollars (\$5.00) nor more than ten dollars (\$10.00) for each table or alley. For motion picture houses or theatres with a seating capacity of three hundred (300) or less twenty five dollars (\$25.00) and five (5) dollars additional for each hundred or fraction thereof in the seating capacity in an excess of Three hundred (300).

For shooting galleries, not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars (25).

For these engaging in such business after June 30th of any year, shall be required to pay half the yearly rate.

The closing hour of the aforementioned places of amusement shall be eleven o' clock P.M. and it shall be unlawful for any owner, proprietor, or operator to permit any game to be continued or any crowds to loiter within such business places between the hours of eleven o' clock P.M. and six o' clock A.M.

The failure to comply with the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a Borough offense and misdemeanor, and upon complaint made before the Chief Burgess, and convicted, the party found guilty shall forfeit and pay as a fine the sum not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than fifty (50) dollars to be collected as fines are by law collectible.

All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
