

ORDINANCE 27

Adopting And Naming Certain Streets And Alleys In The Borough Of Lilly
As Public Highways Thereof And Fixing The Width Of The Same.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania; and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same--that the following named and described streets and alleys be adopted and they are hereby adopted as and declared to be public highways as streets and alleys respectively of the Borough of Lilly, and the width thereof shall be as herein after set forth, to Wit:

Section 2. All that street or part of street beginning at intersection with line of Harris Street; thence south 65 degrees 10 minutes east for a distance of 336.06 feet to the Borough line, this being known as the southern part of Adele Street; thence in a north easterly direction a distance of forty THREE (43) feet to a point; thence north 65 degrees 10 minutes west for a distance of 348.23 feet to the intersection with the line of Harris Street, this street to be known as Adele Street, and to be the width of forty (40) feet.

Section 3. All that alley beginning at intersection with line of Harris Street, thence south 65 degrees 10 minutes east for a distance of 285.57 feet; thence along the Borough line a distance of seventeen (17) feet to a point; thence north 65 degrees 10 minutes west for a distance of 290.44 feet to the intersection with line of Harris Street. This alley to be known as Meyers Alley; and to be of the width of sixteen (16) feet.

Section 4. All that alley beginning at intersection with line of Harris Street, thence south 65 degrees 10 minutes east for a distance of 393.67 feet to the Borough line; thence in a north easterly direction along the Borough line 17 feet to a point; thence north 65 degrees 10 minutes west for a distance of 398.23 feet to a intersection with a line of Harris Street. This alley to be known as Sweeney Alley and to be of a width of sixteen (16) feet.

Section 5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
