ANODINANCE

Expressing a desire of Council of the Borough of Lilly to increase the Bonded Indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly for the following purposes, to-wit:-

"For paying a portion of the Floating Indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly in an amount equal to the proposed increase of Bonded Indebtedness, to-wit the sum of fourteen thousand (\$14,000.00) dollars, and to provide for an election to obtain the assent of the electors thereto". Whereas, the assessed valuation of the Borough of Lilly for the year of 1926 is \$689,826.30; And Whereas, the present Bonded Indebtedness of the Gorough of Lilly is Twenty five thousand dollars, which is 3.6 plus percentum of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property of the Borough of Lilly, and the Floating Indebtedness is \$14,235.00; And Whereas the present bonded Indebtedness is desired to be increased by the Borough of Lilly in the amount of fouteen thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00) for the following purpose, to-wit:

"For paying a portion of the Floating Indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly in a amount equal to the proposed increase of Bonded Indebtedness, to-wit, the sum of fourteen thousand (\$14,000.00) dollars"; And Whereas, the presents Bonded Indebtedness together with the proposed increase of Bonded Indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly of thirty-nine thousand (\$39,000.00) dollars, and with a floating indebtedness of two hundred and thirty-five (\$235.00) dollars, Would make a total indebtedness of thirty-nine thousand two hundred and thirty-five (\$39,235.00) dollars; And whereas, to contract said additional indebtedness it will be necessary to submit the same to the qualified electors of the Boroughof Lilly for the purpose of obtaining their assent thereto;

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Borough of Lilly Council, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same; That it is the desire of Council to increase the indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly byan issue and sale of bonds in the amount of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,000.66) dollars for the Following purpose, to-wit: "For paying a portion of the Floating Indebtedness of the Borough of Lilly in an amount equal to the proposed increase of Bonded Indebtedness, to-wit, the sum of Fourteen Thousand (\$14,660,00) Dollars". Said bonds to be issued and sold in such amounts at suchtimes as Council may deem necessary.

Section 2. For the purpose of obtaining the assent of the qualified electors to the increase of Indebtedness as set forth in Section 1 of this ordinance, there is hereby proclaimed a Public Election to be held on Tuesday, the second day of November, A.D., 1926, between hours of 7 o'clock A.M., and 7 o'clock P.M., at the usual polling places for holding of General and Municipal Elections in the Borough of Lilly, this date being the date of the General Election. The following notice of the said election shall be advertised by weekly advertisements in the Cambria Freeman, a publication of the Borough of Ebensburg, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, and by twenty four (24) hand bills posted in themost public places in the said Borough of Lilly for a period of at least thirty (30) days prior to the date of said election, for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors thereof to such increase of Indebtedness.
