

ORDINANCE 49

An ordinance of the Borough of Lilly in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania providing for the laying of Borough Tax in the Borough of Lilly for the fiscal year of 1928, fixing the millage, etc.

Section 1. Be it enacted and ordained by the Town Council of the Borough of Lilly, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same, that the millage for Borough Tax in and for the Borough of Lilly for the fiscal year of 1928 shall be maintained and shall be the same as the millage for the year of 1927, or a total millage of twenty-one and one half (21½) mills on all assessable property in the Borough of Lilly, being at the rate of fifteen mills for general Borough purposes on each one hundred dollars of assessed property or the sum of \$1.50 for Borough Purposes and six and one half mills for bonded indebtedness for each one hundred dollars of assessed property or the sum of \$0.65 for Bonded Indebtedness.

Any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed so far as the same affects this ordinance.
