ORDINANCE

Ordinance No.: 2022-12 December

*An Ordinance of the Lilly Borough Council
Establishing Certain Tax Rates
for the 2023 Fiscal Year*

WHEREAS, Section 1310 of Pennsylvania's Borough Code (8 Pa.C.S. §101, et. seq.) requires Council to "... adopt the budget by motion of council ..."; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Code imposes a duty upon Council to levy taxes each year in order to fund the budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 1310.1 of the Borough Code states that "... it is the duty of the council to ... enact an ordinance if the tax rate increases from the previous year ..."; and

WHEREAS, the Council has tentatively adopted the 2023 budget and must levy taxes for the year 2023 to fund the annual budget.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Council as follows:

Section 1. The proposed 2023 Borough budget, tentatively approved on December 7, 2022 and advertised for public inspection in conformance with Pennsylvania law is hereby adopted as the Borough's 2023 budget.

Section 2. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a per capita tax in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00).

Section 3. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a local services tax in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00).

Section 4. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a real estate tax of seventeen and one-half (17-1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation for the year 2022 for general purposes.

Section 5. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a realty transfer tax in the amount of one-half of one percent of the fair market value of the property transferred.

Section 6. This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Code, the Local Tax Enabling Act and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Council has determined that this Ordinance is necessary, desirable and proper in order to promote the public health, safety, morals and general welfare and to carry out and effectuate the public purposes of the Borough of Lilly.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2023.
