ORDINANCE

Ordinance No.: 2024-1

*An Ordinance of the Lilly Borough Council
Amending Lilly Borough Ordinance
2013-1 Increasing the Compensation of
Borough Council Members, Council
President and the Mayor*

WHEREAS, Section 1001(e) of Pennsylvania's Borough Code (8 Pa.C.S. §101, et. seq.) requires council members compensation to be fixed by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 1001(e)(1) of the Borough Code authorizes members of council in boroughs with a population of less than five thousand people to receive compensation of up to \$1,875.00 per year; and

WHEREAS, Section 10A04 of the Borough Code requires the Mayor's salary to be established by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 10A04(a)(1) of the Borough Code authorizes mayors in boroughs with a population of less than five thousand people to receive a salary of up to \$2,500.00 per year.

NOW THEREFORE, the Lilly Borough Council hereby and herein **ORDAINS AND ENACTS** the following amendments to Lilly Borough Ordinance 2013-1 ("Ordinance 2013-1"):

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance 2013-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

The duly elected or appointed Mayor of the Borough of Lilly shall receive a salary in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance 2013-1 shall be amended to read as follows:

Duly elected or appointed members of the Lilly Borough Council shall receive compensation in the amount of one hundred twenty (\$120.00) dollars per month.

Section 3. The following Section 2A shall be added to Ordinance 2013-1:

The duly elected President of the Lilly Borough Council shall receive compensation in the amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per month.

Section 4. As per Section 1001(e) of the Borough Code, this increase in Council member compensation shall become effective at the beginning of the next term of the member of Council.

Section 5. As per Section 10A04(b) of the Borough Code, this increase in the Mayor's salary shall become effective at the beginning of the next term of the Mayor.

Section 6. Any provisions of any ordinances or resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby and herein repealed.

Section 7. In all other respects, Ordinance 2013-1 shall remain in full force and effect.
