

LILLY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 1958-3

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION, METHOD AND MANNER OF LAYING SEWERS, SEWERAGE MAINS AND COST OF TAPS FROM SAID MAINS INTO CURBS OF ADJOINING PROPERTY OWNERS AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SAME.

The Borough of Lilly hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. The cost of placing sewers and sewerage pipes in the aforesaid Borough of Lilly shall be on the foot-front plan as follows: All property owners on both sides of the street shall pay into the Borough Treasury within sixty (60) days from the date the sewers are laid in the street in front of their property. such a sum of money for every foot-front of their respective properties that abut on said street as the Borough Council shall from time to time fix by Resolution; providing, however, that where a property owner may own property that is located on a corner, and thus his property abuts on both streets, he may have an option of paying a sum that will pay for the foot-front that is on the most narrow part; but in case a property owner may desire to tap into the sewers running on both streets that pass his property, then he must pay for the foot-front that may be on both streets running past his property.

SECTION 2. The Borough of Lilly must lay the main sewers on the street and make the tap into the main sewer and lay pipes from the main sewer up to the curb of the property owners, and such sum as shall be determined to be due the Borough on a foot-front basis shall be due from the property owners, whether said property owner elects to tap into the sewage system or not, and said amount shall be due on the date that the Borough of Lilly shall see fit to make a tap into the main sewer and place pipe up to the curb of said properties.

SECTION 3. The method of collection for this money due from the property owners for sewers and laying of sewerage pipes shall be as provided by statute of other Municipal liens in Boroughs of this Commonwealth.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances now in existence and inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance, in particular Ordinance No. 21, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall go into effect December 1, 1958.
