

1961 TAX EARNED INCOME

LILLY BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 1961-2

The BOROUGH OF LILLY hereby ordains as follows:

That Ordinance No. 65, imposing an earned income tax of one-half of one per cent ($\frac{1}{2}\%$) on all salaries, wages, commissions, net profits, etc., earned by residents of the Borough of Lilly and by non-residents of the Borough of Lilly for work done or services rendered in the Borough of Lilly, enacted the 22nd day of December, 1956, is hereby re-enacted without substantial changes for the calendar year, 1962.

That Ordinance No. 1960-1 imposing a per capita tax for general revenue purposes of Five (\$5.00) Dollars upon every male and female resident of the Borough of Gallitzin of twenty-one (21) years of age is hereby re-enacted without substantial change for the calendar year 1962.

Ordained and Enacted at a regular meeting held the 25th day of November, 1961.
