## ORDINANCE

An ORDINANCE Prohibiting the Operation and Maintenance of Dog Kennels Within the Boundaries of the Borough of Lilly and Prescribing Penalties for Violations

The Borough of Lilly hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meanings, respectively designated for each:

- 1. The term or the word "person" as used in this Ordinance shall mean any nature of person, partnership, association, firm or corporation, The singular shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine and neuter.
- 2. The word "owner", when applied to the proprietorship of a dog, shall include every person having a right of property in such dog and every person who keeps or harbors such dogs or has in his care, and every person who permits such dogs to remain on or about any premises occupied by him.
- or whereupon four (4) or more dogs, over three months of age, are kept for the purpose of breeding, sale or show purposes.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person to maintain or operate, or permit to be maintained or operated, a dog kennel within the boundaries of the Borough of Lilly.

SECTION III. A dog kennel is deemed to be a public nuisance per se, as detrimental to the public health and peace of the residents of Lilly Borough and may be abated in such manner as is provided by law.

SECTION IV. Any person who shall violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days. Provided: Each day's continuance of the violation or a maximum of five (5) days shall constitute a separate offense.
