*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Sewer Authority
Amending the Lilly Borough Sewer Authority
Sanitary Sewer System Rules and Regulations to
Establish Exemption Criteria for Home Businesses*

WHEREAS, the Lilly Borough Sewer Authority has previously established Rules and Regulations for the use of the Lilly Borough Sanitary Sewer System; and

WHEREAS, the Authority recognizes that low impact home businesses may be conducted within the borough and have minimal to no effect on the home's usage of the sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Authority is desirous of amending the Rules and Regulations to provide for a low impact home business exemption from the "separate use" bill and fee required by Section 108(D).

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Sewer Authority as follows:

Section 108 of the Lilly Borough Sewer Authority Sanitary Sewer System Rules and Regulations is amended to include the following subsection:

- (E) *An LBSA customer who intends to conduct a business from their home may request a home business exemption from Section 108(D) hereof. This exemption may be granted at the sole discretion of the LBSA and shall not be considered permanent and may be reviewed and revoked by the LBSA at any time. The following criteria may be considered by the LBSA in determining whether or not to grant or continue an exemption:*
- (i) *The use must be part-time and incidental to the residential use of the property.*
 - (ii) *The business shall employ no employees other than family members residing in the dwelling.*

- (iii) *The business activity may not generate any solid waste or sewage discharge in quality or quantity other than that associated with normal domestic sewage.*
- (iv) *Any other relevant factor.*

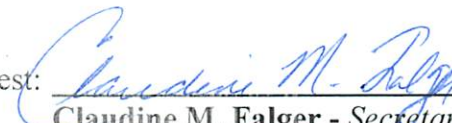
