Resolution No.: 2016-1/November

*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Council
Adopting the Cambria County Hazard
Mitigation Plan*

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lilly, Cambria County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural and human-caused hazards, which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“DMA 2000”) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President, a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Lilly acknowledges the requirement of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan (“HMP”) as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the County’s HMP has been developed by the County’s Department of Public Safety in cooperation with other County departments and officials and citizens of the Borough of Lilly; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to update the County’s HMP; and

WHEREAS, the County's HMP recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-caused hazards that affect the County and its municipal governments.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Council that:

The Cambria County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official hazard mitigation plan of the Borough of Lilly and the respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the County's Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.
