*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Council
Authorizing the Mayor to Issue Citations
for the Enforcement of Borough Ordinances*

WHEREAS, the Borough does not operate a municipal police department; and

WHEREAS, Section 10A07(1) of the Borough Code authorizes borough mayors “to preserve order in the borough, to enforce the ordinances and regulations, to remove nuisances, to exact a faithful performance of the duties of the officers appointed and to perform any other duties as shall be vested in the mayor’s office by law or ordinance”; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Rule of Criminal Procedure (“Pa.R.C.P.”) 103 defines the term “law enforcement officer” as “any person who is by law given the power to enforce the law when acting within the scope of that person’s employment”; and

WHEREAS, The mayor has been held to be the “chief law enforcement officer” in a borough for purposes of the Municipal Police Jurisdiction Act; and

WHEREAS, Pa.R.C.P. 402 provides that “law enforcement officers shall ordinarily institute summary proceedings by citation.”

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Council that:

The duly elected or in the case of a vacancy, duly appointed, Lilly Borough Mayor shall issue citations for the purpose of enforcing the ordinances of Lilly Borough.
