*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Council
Appointing Jeffrey T. Hite, a Registered
Elector of the Borough, to Fill the
Vacancy on Borough Council Created
by the Resignation of Council-Member
Michelle D. Claar*

WHEREAS, a vacancy on the Borough Council has been created by the resignation of Michelle D. Claar (a copy of Ms. Claar's resignation letter is attached hereto); and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council accepted Ms. Claar's resignation at the October meeting of the Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 901(a) of the Borough Code provides that "[i]f any vacancy occurs in the office of . . . member of council . . . the council shall fill the vacancy within 30 days by appointing, by resolution, a registered elector of the borough . . . to hold the office, if the term continues that long, until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election occurring more than 60 days after the vacancy occurs . . ."

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Council that:

Jeffrey T. Hite, a registered elector of the Borough is hereby appointed to the office of Lilly Borough Council Member to serve until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election occurring more than sixty days after the vacancy occurs.

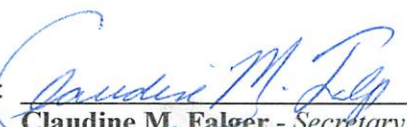

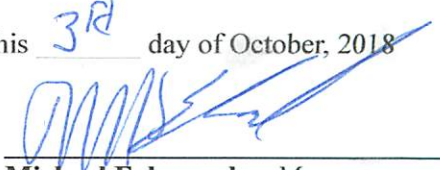
