*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Council
Appointing a Registered Elector of the
Borough to the Vacant Tax Collector Office*

WHEREAS, in 2017, Debra Hartline was re-elected to the office of Lilly Borough Tax Collector; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hartline has submitted her resignation to the Lilly Borough Council (a copy of the resignation letter is attached hereto and incorporated herein); and

WHEREAS, Section 901 of Pennsylvania's Borough Code (8 Pa.C.S. §101, et. seq.) provides that "If any vacancy occurs in the office of . . . tax collector, by . . . resignation . . . the council shall fill the vacancy within 30 days by appointing, by resolution, a registered elector of the borough . . . to hold the office . . . until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election occurring more than 60 days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible individual shall be elected to the office for the remainder of the term."

NOW THEREFORE, the Lilly Borough Council hereby **RESOLVES** as follows:

Section 1: The resignation of Lilly Borough Tax Collector Debra Hartline is hereby accepted.

Section 2: **MaryAnn Sklodowski** is hereby and herein appointed to the office of Lilly Borough Tax Collector and, once qualified, shall hold said office until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election occurring more than sixty days following this appointment.
