RESOLUTION

Resolution No.: 2021-12-2

*A Resolution of the Lilly Borough Council
being the 2022 Tax Resolution*

WHEREAS, Section 1310 of the Borough Code requires Council to “. . . adopt the budget by motion of council . . .”; and

WHEREAS, Section 1310.1 of the Borough Code states that “after council has adopted the budget, it is the duty of the council to adopt a resolution levying the taxes”; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted the 2022 budget and must levy taxes for the year 2022 to fund the annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the tax rates for the fiscal year 2022 shall remain the same as fiscal year 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Lilly Borough Council that the tax rates for the year 2022 are as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a per capita tax in the amount of five dollars (\$5.00).

Section 2. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a local services tax in the amount of thirty dollars (\$30.00).

Section 3. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a real estate tax of twelve and one-half (12-1/2) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation for the year 2021 for general purposes.

Section 4. The Borough of Lilly herein imposes a realty transfer tax in the amount of one-half of one percent of the fair market value of the property transferred.

Section 5. This resolution is enacted pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Code, the Local Tax Enabling Act and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the Council has determined that this resolution is necessary, desirable and proper in order to promote the public health, safety, morals and general welfare and to carry out and effectuate the public purposes of the Borough of Lilly.
